B. Consideration for a new building attached to the west side of Oak Street Inn at 5521 Oak Street.

It was noted the applicant plans to erect an attached 2-story brick building resembling an *old bank* building. It was noted the front door would be at grade and an old St Louis style brick color would be used. The budling would feature solider course brick above the windows, stone windowsills, and sandstone along the top.

Pat Kelly inquired if the roof top would have a railing and if a handicap ramp would be installed. Mr. Shreves stated only one door will be featured on the first and second floor. It was the consensus of the Commission the new building elevations look better than the previous approved building elevations.

Stephen East inquired about the timeline for the Oak Street Inn. Mr. Shreves stated opening by August is the goal.

Stephen East moved approve item B above. Jim Hennessey seconded the motion. Motion was carried by affirmative votes of six (6) members. There were no nay votes and no abstentions.
