Board of Aldermen's Report

Alderman Johnny Gnau reported the waste hauling services started so early in the morning recently that a lot of residents missed their trash service. Alderman Gnau has requested the City investigate setting approximate pick up and or start times.

Alderman Krekeler reported the recent Parks & Recreation Advisory Committee meeting was a good one and some items they discussed were kayak landings, bank stabilization options, trail connectivity ideas. Mr. Krekeler also reported they established sub committees.




Adjournment of Meeting

Staff Reports

City Administrator

During the meeting, City Administrator Michael Padella reviewed the agenda items with the Mayor and Board of Aldermen, including the public hearings and consent agenda items.

A discussion was held regarding 1340 St. Peters Cottleville Road in relation to various industrial uses. It was noted the college light industrial is more restrictive.

Mr. Padella reviewed the consent agenda items including change orders for Bommarito construction slab replacement work. It was noted plastic soil was found in some areas causing an increase.

Mr. Padella reviewed a new boundary adjustment process that has not been in place therefore it would be new to the City. It was noted bill 26-016 allows the City to utilize them for additional work while they are doing work for SCC Highway Department in Cottleville.

Police Chief

During this time, Chief McCune explained the resolutions on tonight's agenda in regard to the Blue Shield Grant Program for Flock Safety Cameras, Gentec Cameras and MDT's. He also discussed Resolution 26-06 in regard to the 2026 FIFA World Cup Mutual Aid options. However, he further stated he may not be able to provide officers.

Chief McCune also stated a donation of \$25,000.00 has been received for a future K9 dog.

City Clerk/Treasurer

Amy Lewis, City Clerk - Treasurer – provided a bill list, various minutes.

City Attorney

Drew Weber, City Attorney, was present for the meeting. Nothing further at this time.

Communications from the Alderman

Alderman Krekeler inquired if the City or City Engineer was inspecting that the street slabs are being put in correctly.

Alderman Holt inquired about the home inspection process and whether it includes verifying window ratings after installed. City Attorney, Drew Weber stated the City would not be liable for verify window ratings in a home inspection.

It was noted CBB has finished the traffic study for the Mid Rivers Mall Drive area near Calvary Church in regard to the pending Impact Soccer application. It was noted that it did warrant a traffic signal for the area.

Nothing at this time.




Adjournment
