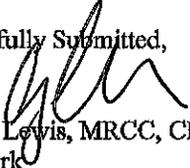
A. Comprehensive Plan Update

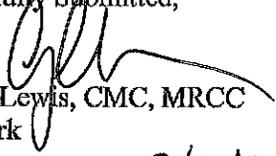
Mayor Thompson inquired if they could sell liquor. It was noted package to go liquor would require another conditional use permit approval.

Adjournment

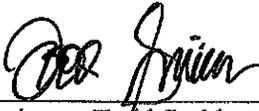
