The City of Cottleville hosted the second Comprehensive Plan Update Open House, led by PGAV Planners, for residents and the general public. During the open house, PGAV reviewed the results of the community survey, which received more than 712 responses, as well as feedback gathered through area stakeholder interviews.

PGAV also presented several exhibits, including a draft Future Land Use Map, a Growth and Annexation exhibit, and a Parks, Greenways, and Trail Connections exhibit. Residents, business owners, City staff, elected officials, and various board and commission members were invited to provide feedback using markers on the exhibits, comment cards, and stickers to identify priorities and preferences.

Also in attendance were several City staff members, the City Administrator Michael Padella, the City Engineer Tom Goldkamp, Mayor Stephen Thompson, Alderman Johnny Gnau, Alderman Elizabeth Holt, and Alderman Mike Krekeler. Planning and Zoning Commission members Maria Conte, Stan Enloe, and Terry Hogan were also present, along with Maria Tasios representing the Old Town Historic Commission. Various Parks and Recreation Advisory members were also present such as LeaAnn Grimshaw and Jamie Goodwin

PGAV plans to host a third Comprehensive Plan Update Open House on August 27 at 5:30 p.m. at Cottleville City Hall.
