

Cottleville Golf Cart Regulations Municipal Code 340.105

* Golf carts only. No ATV's or other utility vehicles.

- MUST BE 16 years of age with a valid driver's license
 & proof of insurance.
- * SLOW DOWN, MOVE OVER.
 Pedestrians & cyclists have the right of way.
- Golf cart drivers should not carry more passengers than the golf cart is designed to carry.
- Head & tail lamps required before dawn & after sunset.
- * No golf cart should be operated on private property without the permission of the owner.
- * Golf carts CAN be driven on streets which have a maximum speed limit of 30 mph or less & on sidewalks or trails greater than 6 feet wide. No golf carts on the sidewalk in the Historic Cottleville area. Please use the roadways.
- * No golf cart shall cross any highway at an intersection where the highway being crossed has a posted speed limit of more than 45 mph. USE SIGNALIZED AREAS.

All traffic laws apply to golf carts. Violations are enforced by the Cottleville Police Department & processed through the Cottleville Municipal Court.
