7. Citizen Petitions and Public Comments.

A. A Public Hearing for a Rezoning and Planned Urban Development Area Plan for Prairie Bluff.

Chris DeGuentz with Fischer & Frichtel Homes and Jim Sims with Bax Engineering presented plans to provide a 51-home subdivision on 32 acres at 5261 and 5271 Gutermuth Road. Lot sizes range from 16,400 to 31,772 square feet. Starting home prices are estimated between \$486,900-\$720,900.00 for 2,220-3,720 square foot of living space and 3 car garages. An extensive landscaping buffer with trees and wrought iron fencing will be provided along Gutermuth Road. The subdivision will have two entrances off Gutermuth Road and two detention basins for any storm water. Mr. Sims stated plans include sidewalks on one side of the street, 26-foot-wide streets and a minimum center line radius which is customary in some area neighborhoods. Mr. DeGuentz stated they hope to get started on the project next spring with some grading starting as soon as possible. Mr. Sims stated St. Charles County plans to begin widening Gutermuth Road at about the same time.

Staff Reports

a.) City Attorney

Drew Weber, City Attorney was present for the meeting, Mr. Weber discussed the recent passage of amendment 3 as well as when an election is required regarding the same. Chief James stated it is difficult to prosecute any offenses now that remain.

b.) City Administrator & Public Works Director

Rich Francis, City Administrator, reviewed the consent agenda and all other agenda items for tonight's meeting such as: Cottleville Trails plat 1, a new dental facility at 475 Miralgo Way, stop work orders, and amending the code in regard to home based businesses in order to comply with Missouri law. In addition, Mr. Francis discussed the rezoning and PUD for Prairie Bluff. Mr. Francis provided sample elevations, prices points and comparable subdivisions. It was noted St. Charles County already has plans to begin widening Gutermuth Road including an 8-foot-wide trail on both sides of the road.

Alderman Krekeler inquired about building in the flood plain. It was noted the flood way cannot be filled in, but at this time FEMA permits property to be developed in the flood plain if the structures are built above it, such as Miralago, Rosedale, Madison, Meadow Lake, Patriot Ridge, and Columbus Pointe etc.

Mr. Francis also reviewed the annexation of 5271 Gutermuth Road, He also discussed the engineering services needed for additional parking spaces on Chestnut near the Post Office, stop work orders and new speed limits on Highway N which was requested by the Board of Aldermen previously. It was noted Mr. Francis would be making other code revisions that are needed as time allows.

Alderman Guccione moved to suspend the rules for Bills 22-62, 64, 66 and 67. Alderman Stiles seconded the motion. Motion was carried by affirmative votes of four (4) Aldermen. There were no nay votes and no abstentions.

During this time, Mr. Francis reviewed the pavilion rates for residents and nonresidents for Cottleville as well as the rates from other cities within St. Charles County. It was noted Cottleville was among the lowest. Alderman Stiles moved to set the Cottleville pavilion rental fees as follows:
