

BARK PARK RULES and REGULATIONS

DOG OWNERS/HANDLERS ARE RESPOSIBLE FOR THE ACTIONS AND BEHAVIOR OF THEIR DOG(S) AT ALL TIMES!

BARK PARK HOURS ARE FROM SUNRISE TO SUNSET

- All dogs must be under the control of an adult.
- ·Limit of two (2) dogs per adult.
- Children under eight (8) should be supervised by an adult.
- Dog owner / handler is responsible for picking up and properly disposing of their dog's waste into a trash receptacle.
- No other animals may be brought into fenced area.
- All dogs must be leashed when entering and leaving the bark park.
- Dogs under four (4) months of age are prohibited.
- Dogs in heat are prohibited.
- Dogs showing any signs of aggression must be leashed and immediately removed from the bark park.
- Never leave your dog(s) unattended in the bark park.
- Dogs must be in view of and within voice control of their owner / handler at all times.
- Dog owner / handler must carry a leash with them at all times while in the bark park.
- Pinch, choker chains and spiked collars must be removed from dogs prior to entering the bark park.
- Glass containers, food in bowls, long lasting chews and human food are not allowed in the bark park.
- Dog owner / handler must stop their dog(s) from digging and are responsible for filling any holes.
