Preservation of the Cottleville Trails Drive Corridor, Denied

At a recent special meeting, the Cottleville Board of Aldermen considered Resolution No. 25-07, which would have exercised the City's option under the existing Planned Unit Development Agreement (PUD) to create and preserve a "Cottleville Trails Drive Corridor" for possible future dedication and construction of a connecting roadway and bridge.

After discussion, the Resolution did not pass, with a vote of 2 opposed, 1 in favor, and 1 abstention.

This outcome follows an extensive period of review and public engagement. During the past several weeks, the City received significant community input through the Cottleville Trails Drive Corridor Traffic Study, a public open house, and a community questionnaire survey. Many residents shared their perspectives, comments, and suggestions, which were carefully reviewed and presented to the Board before its deliberation.

The City of Cottleville extends its sincere appreciation to everyone who attended the open house, completed and returned the survey, or contacted City officials to share their views. Your participation and feedback play an essential role in shaping community decisions and priorities.
