Staff Reports

City Administrator

During the meeting, City Administrator Michael Padella reviewed the agenda items with the Mayor and Board of Aldermen, including the public hearing, consent agenda, and other business items.

Discussion was held regarding the City's fleet of mowers, including how many are currently in service and when the most recent mower was purchased.

Mr. Padella also stated he reviewed the inventory of City laptops and desktop computers. The City's IT provider has recommended a replacement schedule for the oldest equipment; however, two additional computers will also be needed to accommodate new staff positions.

It was noted that the Planning and Zoning Commission recommended approval of the Conditional Use Permit for 5285 Highway N, Suite 102, in Cottleville.

Mr. Padella reviewed Terra Engineering Task Order No. 1, which includes additional design work for improvements in the Lime, Main, and Chestnut Street areas.

In addition, the Rotary Club has requested permission to install a Peace Pole in Legacy Park. This item is included on the evening's agenda for Board consideration.

Mr. Padella also discussed the ordinance establishing the City's Veterans Advisory Committee, which is on the evening's agenda. The committee will be open to both residents and non-residents who are interested in serving.

Police Chief

During this time, Chief McCune explained the use of Flock cameras and it's audit system.

City Clerk/Treasurer

Amy Lewis, Director of Administrative Services – provided a bill list and noted the server has been up and down. She further stated the City is getting a new server. Mrs. Lewis also reviewed the City's reservable facilities and the current policies and procedures for reserving and using those spaces. Following

discussion, the consensus of the Board of Aldermen was to make no changes to the existing reservation policies or procedures.

City Attorney

Drew Weber, City Attorney, was present for the meeting. Nothing further at this time.

Communications from the Alderman

Alderman Krekeler inquired about the condition of the historic bridge and or its components located within Cottleville Trails. He also asked about the status of a demolition permit for the vacant home located on Highway N at the entrance to his subdivision, Timberwoods Farms.
